

MATERIALS AND SIZES

Available Materials

Kalisher currently has many amazing materials on which we can print our artwork!

Archival Matte Paper: our standard paper material, archival to 75+ years depending on lighting, most cost effective material

Gallery Wrapped Canvas: our standard canvas material, once wrapped on stretcher bars, the image extends onto the sides of the product

Canvas on Hardboard: we also print and finish canvas unstretched, within a frame

Vinyl Wallcovering: type II fire rated, vinyl wallcovering in a variety of surfaces & finishes

Aluminum Sheet: thin all metal surface, typically mounted on standoffs

Aluminum Dibond: metal sheets as front and back surface, supported by a black poly-foam core, 1/4" thick overall.

Glass: clear glass sheets, frosted glass can be sourced or printed, should be tempered glass

Acrylic: clear acrylic sheets, frosting is typically done through the printing process

Wood: typically high quality plywood, can also source hardwood though it is more expensive

Fabric: any fabric, the sky is the limit

Anything & Everything: seriously, anything that can be printed on, we can print on it. Plates, curtains, frames.

Sizes to Know

Glass and Mat Board

Standard: Glass and mat board come in two standard sizes:

- 40" x 32"
- 60" x 40"

Note: Our standard clear glass is 3/16" thick.

Oversize Mat Boards: There are oversize mat boards that incur additional costs and lead times:

- 48" x 96"
- 60" x 104"

Note: Only select colors available for oversize mat boards.

Plexiglass Anything outside of the STANDARD dimensions for glass will justify using plexiglass instead.

- The largest plexiglass panel we can use is 72" x 96"
- Plexiglass is available in 1/8", 1/4" and 1/2" thickness.

Sizes to Know (cont'd)

Moulding

Moulding sticks come in standard lengths of 10 feet. Due to parts of the manufacturing process, quoting frame sizes beyond 96" for any dimension is not preferred.

Maximum Substrate Sizes

- Glass: 60" x 60"
- Metal: 96" x 48"
- Acrylic: 96" x 48"
- Wood: 96" x 48"
- Paper & Canvas: 58" or less on the shortest side

Some materials may be larger on special order; please ask!

Spec Suggestions

Deckle Edge Item

Deckle edge prints look best when the print has room to breathe. Allow enough space between the edge of the print and the edge of the frame so that the artwork is truly highlighted.

Example: 26" x 32" OFD can stand to have 1.5" - 4" mat reveals ; Most sizes can be given at least 1" - 1.5" mat reveals
